Note: (i) Tender Cost and EMD is exempted for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with District Industries Centre or Khadi & Village Industries Commission or Khadi & Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Dte of Handicraft & Handloom or any other bodies specified by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises for appropriate category and have valid registration certificate as on date of tendersubmission.

CAMC of LVS System in NMRC

The MSEs would not be eligible for exemption of EMD if:

- a. Either they are not registered for appropriate category.
- b. Or they do not have valid registration as on the date of tender submission.

The tenderers seeking exemption from 'EMD', being MSEs, shall ensure their eligibility w.r.t above and submit registration certificate issued by the body under which they are registered which clearly mentions category of registration i.e. "**Repair of Communication equipment**" and Terminal Validity of registration.

In absence of any of the above requirements no exemption for 'EMD' will be allowed and tenderers eligibility shall be dealt as if they are not registered with MSMEs.

No further clarification shall be sought on the above.

1. In case the bidder who has been exempted Tender Cost/EMD being Micro & Small Enterprise, and;
 - (i) withdraws his Tender during the period of Tender validity; or
 - (ii) becomes the successful bidder, but fails to commence the work (for whatsoever reasons) as per terms & conditions of Tender; or
 - (iii) refuses or neglects to execute the contract; or
 - (iv) fails to furnish the required Performance Security within the specified time,

The bidder shall be debarred from participating in future tenders for a period of 1 year from the date of discharge of tender/date of cancellation of NOA/annulment of award of contract as the case may be. Thereafter, on expiry of period of debarment, the bidder may be permitted to participate in the procurement process only on submission of required Tender Cost/ EMD.

Further the Employer may advise the authority responsible for issuing the exemption certificate to take suitable actions against the bidder such as cancellation of enlistment certificate etc.

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Section 1: General Information

1.1 Background

- a. Noida and Greater Noida are being developed as the satellite towns to New Delhi and more and more people from Delhi and other areas are shifting to these towns in search of fresh air, greenery and better infrastructure. There is a need of providing an efficient, reliable and comfortable transportation system for the population intending to settle in these towns and also the public coming to these areas for education, service and business.
- b. Noida Metro Rail Corporation is a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) formed for planning and executing urban transport projects in Noida, Greater Noida regions. The Company desires to provide a world-class Public Transportation System with state-of-the-art technology. As such, the overarching criterion for setting up of the Company is to help create an efficient, safe, reliable, economical and affordable public transport system
- c. An elevated metro line between Noida and Greater Noida is already in operation.
- d. NMRC invites E-Bids for selection of Contractor for granting the Contract for CAMC for LVS system in NMRC at NMRC Depot.
- e. In this regard, the Corporation now invites the interested Bidder/s to submit their proposals as per provisions of this Request for Proposal Document.
- f. NMRC will shortlist the Bidders on the basis of evaluation criteria mentioned in this RFP Document. On the basis of the minimum evaluation criteria, qualified Bidders will be shortlisted. Financial proposal of only qualified Bidders will be opened.
- g. The Successful Bidder shall provide the services as described in Section 2:Terms of Reference.

1.2 About Locations

The metro corridor is 29.7 km long and is known as Noida Greater Noida Metro Rail Corridor. It comprises 21 metro stations starting from Noida Sector 51 in Noida and ends up at Depot Station in Greater Noida.

Section 2: Terms of Reference

2.1 Tenure:

The term shall be up to Three (03) Years from contract signing, unless otherwise terminated by the Parties in accordance with the terms. CAMC contract will be awarded for Three (03) Years, which shall be extended for another one (01) Year on mutual agreement after satisfactory performance.

2.2 Scope of Work:

NMRC has set up 02 number video walls at OCC Building, NMRC Depot. These three large video screens (LVS) are being used by Electrical Traction and Signalling and Departments . The detail of specifications is given in the 2.2.9.

LVS in Electrical Traction Department is used to get view and control of Traction Power Supply Sectioning and Paralleling at Noida Metro Aqua Line. LVS in Signalling Department is used to get view of different train routes and control the metro train movements at Noida Metro Aqua Line.. All the two Large Video Screens are used 24x7 to get respective views, and therefore these views are very critical.

CAMC of LVS (Large Video Screen) of Signalling and Traction Department includes LVSs of Signalling and Traction Department only.

2.2.1 Repair/Replacement of defective parts

CAMC shall include the repair / replacement of defective parts. All the parts repaired/replaced must have equivalent or higher specification. Also, the consumables like keyboard, mouse, cabling and connectors etc. will be in the scope of contractor. The details of replacement such as serial number, part code/ number etc. should be provided to the competent authority and a log must be maintained .During this period the system must not work in degraded mode, therefore a standby arrangement is also mandatory in such cases. The bidder must maintain software to available for NMRC use for call attending, tracking & spare repair/ replacement. The tool must be able to give reports to NMRC in pdf/ word/ excel formats.

2.2.2 Repairing of LVS Equipment

The equipment are normally required to be repaired in the premises of NMRC only. In exceptional cases when the equipment cannot be repaired in NMRC premises and required to be taken to the workshop, NMRC will not make any payment towards cartage and the expense for the to and fro transportation of the machines will be borne by the firm concerned. The equipment being taken to the workshop for repair would be at contractor/firm own risk and expenses. Any damage or loss caused to the equipment or their part due to negligence, mishandling shall be made good by the contractor/firm. In this case, the contractor/firm should make necessary inward and outward entries duly signed by the Duty Supervisor of NMRC. The contractor will ensure travel cost of his source engineer at his own risk & cost.

In case NMRC feels repair work is not resolving the problem or up to the expectation of NMRC then contractor would be require to replace all such system with fresh spare as per decision of NMRC.

2.2.3 Log book for Repair/Replacement

The firm will prepare separate department-wise log books for each type of equipment in LVS system taken under CAMC. Each repair/replacement of equipment will be logged in the respective register. Every entry in this register will be verified and signed by the Duty Supervisor of NMRC. These log books must be kept ready at all time and produced whenever asked to do so.

2.2.4 Un-interrupted live feed at LVS

The contractor/firm has to ensure uninterrupted view on both the Large Video Screens as quoted above.

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The views on Large Video Screens are related to critical operations, therefore regular proper health checks must be ensured for both LVSs . If any anomaly found during these checks the same must be attended on priorities basis so as to ensure uninterrupted view on both the Large Video Screens. The record of Health check must be maintained properly.

In case unavailability of network connectivity at any of the two locations, the selected bidder shall be responsible for updating the content by visiting the site, without any extra cost to NMRC.

2.2.5 Preventive Maintenance and Cleaning of all Hardware.

The contractor/firm shall also be responsible for deployment of necessary staff for regular Preventive Maintenance which is Quarterly for external hardware cleaning and Half Yearly for Deep Hardware cleaning for all the equipment of LVS System using suitable cleaning material and supportive equipment. Maintenance of Video wall will be done annually. Preventive maintenance includes proper network cabling and tightening of any loose connections. A separate log book shall be maintained for preventive maintenance record and it should be verified and signed by the Duty Supervisor of NMRC. 2.2.6 In Case of Damage

CAMC will be onsite and comprehensive in nature and will include all costs of resolution of any kind of issues and replacement of any kind of hardware/items/components of the LED video wall. However NMRC will only consider physically damaged item due to water/mishandling for cost basis repair on case to case basis on NMRC approval.

2.2.7 Other Works related to LVS required by NMRC

The selected bidder shall undertake all other activities as per the requirement of the purchaser, which are related to proper functioning or improvement of both the LVS. These activities may include, but not be limited to-

- A. Any cabling which is related to upgradation of LVS or any other other requirement raised by NMRC.
- B. Any Load Shifting requirements.
- C. Activities for de-installation and re-installation of LVS and its associated equipment.

2.2.8 Availability of man power and Escalation matrix

- The contractor/firm shall ensure the availability of at least One manpower on call basis 24x7, in order to attend failure related to LVS system.
- The system engineer must have the minimum qualification of diploma/B.Tech in electronics/electrical engineer with field experience of atleast five years.
- All system engineers to be well trained in handling LVS.
- Contractor will routinely brief them on safety aspects metro railways.
- Contractor will take undertaking from them of Knowledge of proper safety standards in metro system.

Also, contractor/firm shall provide escalation matrix (with proper designations, contact numbers and E-mail IDs) atleast up to three levels. NMRC JE / maintainer will also assist in carrying out repair / replacement by means of providing PTW (Permit to work)/access to locations and other support etc. from NMRC.

2.2.10 Availability of Spares

- The successful bidder has to maintain a bare minimum spares to maintain the system.
- If required NMRC can provide storage space for keeping the day to day spares/tools items. However,

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the contractor shall be solely responsible for all its items stored in NMRC premises.

- iii. Any software upgradation required during the period of contract shall be borne/upgraded by the contractor.
- iv. NMRC reserves the right to inspect all/contract spares to be maintained by contractor at any point of time.

2.2.11 Tools and Equipment

All tools and testing instruments required for checking, testing and attending of routine maintenance and breakdowns shall be arranged by the Contractor/firm. Also transportation of these tools and instruments shall be arranged by the contractor/firm.

Software tool for call logging / tracking / performing maintenance with the provision of reports must be provided to NMRC. The tool must have atleast three levels of user logins.

2.2.12 Post Contract handover

It shall be the responsibility of the firm to make whole LVS system and equipment work satisfactorily throughout the contract period and to hand over the systems in working conditions to this department after expiry of the contract.

2.2.13 Confidentiality

The contractor/firm must ensure confidentiality regarding handling of all information obtained within the control room, whether videotapes, snapshots, written, verbal and other sensitive materials held within the NMRC premises. The Contractor/firm should ensure all storage and apparatus should be virus free. The service engineer/technicians will be allowed to work 24x7. Renting, lending and copying of any software and hardware products are completely prohibited.

Note: Further NMRC also reserve the right to impose any amount of penalty which may arise due the negligence/manhandling of contractor/failure to attend the fault with in stipulated time.

2.2.15 Do's and Don'ts for contractor Staff

2.2.15.1 DO's

1. In case of fire/ anything unusual on electric traction equipment or wires, inform the respective Engineer-in-charge.
2. Extinguish fire by special extinguishers (carbon tetrachloride or carbon dioxide type), If available.
3. Ensure no water jet to be directed at the fire under any circumstances.
4. Before taking up the work on a line running parallel to 25 KV AC lines, the line shall be earthed on both sides. Ensure that the distance between the two earths used for protection does not exceed 1km.
5. Keep clear of the track and avoid contact with the rails when electric train within 250m.
6. Special care should be taken to carry long pipes, poles or ladders so that it should not come in contact with or within 2 meters of live OHE.
7. Cleaning work other than that of surface (i.e. of beam, pillars etc.) should be done during block period only.
8. Whenever washing or cleaning using water jets is done, take appropriate power block.
9. Cases of electric shock arising out of contact with 25 KV A.C. traction equipment shall be reported immediately to TPC.

2.2.15.2 DON'Ts

1. Do not approach within 2 meters of any traction wires or live equipment.
2. Do not work on or near traction wires or any live equipment unless they are made dead, earthed and shut down notices/ permit to work obtained.
3. Do not enter any switching station or remote control center unless specially permitted.
4. Do not touch a person in contact with live traction wires. Remove body only after power supply is switched off & earthed.
5. Do not touch any traction wire hanging from the mast or fallen on the ground and do not allow anyone else to touch it.
6. Cleaning work with conducting materials like Aluminium/ Steel rods should be avoided at all times when power block is not availed.
7. Do not lift or raise your tools towards traction wires.
8. Do not damage the plinth continuity, connection to BEC, OPC and handrail continuity.
9. Do not use steel tape or metallic tape or tape with woven metal reinforcement in electrified area.
10. Do not forget to give artificial respiration to the victim as per the prescribed procedure laid down at shock treatment charts.
11. Metallic telescopic rods are prohibited for use in the NMRCstation.
12. Do not throw garbage in haste. Dispose it properly at designated place.
13. Contractor has to submit undertaking in specified Proforma w.r.t Does & Don'ts related to danger of work in the vicinity of 25KVtraction.

2.2.16 SAFETY

2.2.16.1 Contractor shall adopt the necessary safety procedures to avoid any type of accidents to Employer's personnel, any other personnel & to avoid damages to NMRCassets.

2.2.16.2 The contractor shall display necessary sign ages while carrying out the work.

2.2.17 ACCIDENTS:

2.2.17.1 It shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor to adopt all the safety measures & deploy personnel who are adequately trained in safety.

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2.2.17.2 If any accident occurs within the station and associated area due to installation work or due to negligence on the part of the contractor’s personnel it shall be the full responsibility of the Contractor.

2.2.17.3 If any damage occurs to the structures/ material & equipment due to installation work, the cost of damage will be recovered from the contractor’s bill.

2.2.17.4 Contractor shall submit the indemnity bond such that “The contractor indemnifies NMRC against any Accidents or damages or losses or Liabilities arising out of his negligence” and contractor’s staff shall not claim of any type, payment, and employment etc. with employer. After completion of contract the contractor shall withdraw all of his staff from the site without any claim.

2.2.18 Service Level Agreement and Penalty:

Service Level Agreement (SLA) defines the terms of the successful bidder’s responsibility in ensuring the performance of the network based on the agreed performance indicators as detailed in the agreement. successful bidder has to co- ordinate with respective supervisor and get the complaint closed and also has to keep proper records.

2.2.18.1 The table below summarizes the performance indicators for the services to be offered by the bidder

9.	Planned System outage	‘Planned System Outage’ refers to unavailability of System due to preventive maintenance activities. Details related to such planned outage shall be approved by the TENDERER or authorized authority and shall be notified to all the concerned persons in advance (at least 24 Hours). It is desirable that such outage shall be taken on non-revenue hours.
10.	Unplanned System outage	‘Unplanned System Outage’ refers to unavailability of System due to failure/Breakdown and corrective maintenance. Unplanned system outage must not exceed 1 day in any case, which is ‘Turnaround time’.

2.2.18.2 Appropriate Penalties will be recovered from the quarterly payment if successful bidder is not able to achieve required Service levels as mentioned below:

2.2.18.3 Maximum cumulative penalty must not exceed 10 (Ten Percent) of CAMC value in any case. Failing which contract would deem to be terminated.

2.3 Obligation to the Contractor

If any damages / loss / theft etc. occurs in the NMRC premise due to mismanagement of contractor, it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and necessary compensation shall be paid by the contractor to NMRC as per the actual cost assessed by NMRC.

The contractor shall indemnify and hold NMRC harmless from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of, or resulting from the works/services under the contract provided by the contractor.

Contractor shall ensure that its personnel shall not at any time, without the consent of NMRC, in writing, divulge or make known any trust, accounts, matter or transaction undertaken or handled by NMRC and shall not disclose to any person information to the affairs of NMRC.

All necessary reports, records, registers and other information, under the Contract and all other Statutory Laws, shall be deposited by the contractor on demand by NMRC.

Any damage or loss caused by contractor's persons to the property & equipment of NMRC Ltd. in whatever form may be recovered from the contractor. Contractor shall not be held responsible for the damages/sabotage caused to the property of NMRC due to the trade union / riots / mobs / armed dacoit activities or any other event of force majeure.

Any liabilities arising out of any litigation (including those in consumer courts) due to any act of contractor's personnel shall be directly borne by contractor including all expenses/fines. The concerned contractor's personnel shall attend the court as & when required.

Any damage due to the mishandling of LVS system or equipment by the contractor staff shall be borne by the contractor itself.

Contractor will also provide support/way-out to protect LVS/Accessories due to rodent/ environmental conditions.

NMRC will only consider physically damaged item due to water/mishandling for cost basis repair on case to case basis on NMRC approval.

All conveyance/Transportation is to be borne by contractor itself.

Contractor is to ensure minimum wages of its staff deployed at NMRC system and submit undertaking to NMRC pertaining to this.

Section 3: Instructions to Bidders

3.1 General instructions

- a.** A tenderer shall submit only one bid in the same tendering process, individually as a tenderer. A tenderer who submits or participates in, more than one bid will cause all of the proposals in which the tenderer has participated to be disqualified. No tenderer can be a sub-contractor while submitting a bid individually. A tenderer, if acting in the capacity of subcontractor in any bid, may participate in more than one bid, but only in that capacity.
- b.** The Bidder shall initiate, and actively pursue and involve itself in all investigations and enquiries, Corporation feedbacks, information, convening of and attendance at meetings, and in any other activities as are or may be necessary for producing high quality work as per the requirements.
- c.** The Bidder shall carry out the services in compliance with the provisions of this Agreement. Any and all changes necessary to ensure that the Bidder's documents conform to the intent and purpose set out in the Agreement, shall be made at the Bidder's own expense. The Bidder represents that it is a professional and experienced company, and hereby agrees to bear full responsibility for the correctness and technical merit of the services performed.
- d.** Bidders shall be evaluated on the basis of the Evaluation Criteria specified in this document. Bidders shall be deemed to have understood and agreed that no explanation or justification for any aspect of the Selection Process will be given and that NMRC's decisions are without any right of appeal whatsoever.
- e.** Any entity which has been barred by the Central/State Government in India or by any entity controlled by them, from participating in any project, and the bar subsists as on the date of Bid, would not be eligible to submit an e -Bid.
- f.** Bidders are encouraged to inform themselves fully about the assignment and the local conditions before submitting the e-Bid by paying a visit to the Corporation and/or by sending written queries to NMRC before the last date for receiving queries/clarifications.
- g.** NMRC shall not be liable for any omission, mistake or error on the part of the Bidder in respect of any of the above or on account of any matter or thing arising out of or concerning or relating to e-Bid or the Selection Process, including any error or mistake therein or in any information or data given by NMRC.
- h.** The currency for the purpose of the Proposal shall be the Indian Rupee(INR).
- i.** Tenderers shall not have a conflict of interest. All Tenderers found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Tenderers shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
- i. A tenderer has been engaged by the Employer to provide consulting services for the preparation related to procurement or implementation of the project;
 - ii. A tenderer is any associates/affiliates (inclusive of parent firms) mentioned in sub paragraph above; or
 - iii. A tenderer lends, or temporarily seconds its personnel to firms or organizations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for an implementation of the project, if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project.

3.1.1 Cost of Bid Document / e-Tender processing Fee

- a.** The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its e-Bid and Noida Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. ("NMRC" or "the Corporation"), will in no case be responsible or liable for

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these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the e-Bid process.

b. This tender document is available on the web site <http://etender.up.nic.in> or on NMRC website (www.nmrcnoida.com) to enable the tenderers to view, download the e-Bid document and submit e-Bids online up to the last date and time mentioned in e-Tender notice/e-tender document against this e-Tender. The tenderers shall have to pay cost of bid document/ e- Tender processing fee of as mentioned in **Data Sheet** through RTGS/NEFT only payable in favor of Noida Metro Rail Corporation Limited in the A/c No. mentioned in **Data Sheet**. The scanned copy of RTGS/NEFT receipt with transaction Id certified by the same bank must be enclosed along with the e-Bid. This cost of bid document/ e-Tender processing fee as mentioned in **Data Sheet** will be non-refundable. Tender without cost of bid document/ e-Tender processing fee in the prescribed form, will not be accepted.

c. Tenderers are required to attach a cancelled cheque of theirs for refund of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) along with Form 10.

3.1.2 Acknowledgement by Bidder

It shall be deemed that by submitting the e-Bid, the Bidder has:

- a. made a complete and careful examination of the Bid;
- b. received all relevant information requested from NMRC;
- c. acknowledged and accepted the risk of inadequacy, error or mistake in the information provided in the e-Bid or furnished by or on behalf of NMRC;
- d. satisfied itself about all matters, things and information, necessary and required for submitting an informed Application and performance of all of its obligations thereunder;
- e. acknowledged that it does not have a Conflict of Interest; and
- f. Agreed to be bound by the undertaking provided by it under and in terms hereof.

3.1.3 Availability of Bid Document

This Bid document is available on the web site <http://etender.up.nic.in> or on Noida Metro website www.nmrcnoida.com to enable the Bidders to view, download the e-Bid document and submit e-Bids online up to the last date and time mentioned in e-Bidder notice/ e-Bid document. The Bidder's shall have to pay e-Bid document fee and EMD as mentioned in Data sheet through RTGS/ NEFT on addresses given in data sheet. The scanned copy of RTGS/ NEFT with transaction ID certified by the same bank must be enclosed along with the e-Bid. This e-Bid document fee will be non-refundable. Bid without Bid fee in the prescribe form will not be accepted.

3.1.4 Clarifications of e-Bid

- a. During evaluation of e-Bid, NMRC may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for a clarification of his/her e-Bid. The request for clarification shall be in writing.
- b. Any queries or request for additional information concerning this RFP shall be submitted in writing or by fax and e-mail to the Dy. General Manager/AFC-Tele, NMRC **only before or during Pre-Bid Meeting** held at NMRC. The envelopes/ communication shall clearly bear the following identification/ title: "**Queries/ Request for Additional Information: CAMC of LVS System in NMRC**". The responses will be posted to all such queries on the official Website www.nmrcnoida.com. NMRC reserves the right not to respond to any questions or provide any clarifications, in its sole discretion, and nothing in this Clause shall be taken or read as compelling or requiring NMRC to respond to any question or to provide any clarification.
- c. A pre-bid meeting shall be called on the date mentioned in **Data Sheet** at NMRC Office. Any change corresponding to date, if any, shall be communicated to the Bidder vide NMRC/ e-Tendering website. All queries regarding pre-bid must reach NMRC on or before pre-bid meeting. No queries will be entertained after the prescribed times as defined in the data sheet of tender document.
- d. Minutes of pre-bid meeting will be published in either e-procurement

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website <http://etender.up.nic.in> or NMRC's website www.nmrcnoida.com.

- e. In case the Bidder seeks for any queries, he shall send letter or e-mail to the correspondence address given in Data Sheet.
- f. However, NMRC shall not entertain any correspondence from the Bidders during the period of e- Bid opening to selection of the successful Bidder. Any wrong practice shall be dealt in accordance with the Section 5.14 of this e-Bid document under Fraud and Corrupt Practices.
- g. The Tenderer is advised to visit and examine the Site of Works and its surroundings and obtain for himself on his own responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the Tender and entering into a contract for the proposed work. The costs of visiting the Site shall be borne by the Tenderer. It shall be deemed that the Contractor has undertaken a visit to the Site of Works and is aware of the site conditions prior to the submission of the tender documents.
- h. The Tenderer and any of his personnel will be granted permission by the Employer to enter upon his premises and lands for the purpose of such inspection, but only upon the express condition that the Tenderer, and his personnel, will release and indemnify the Employer and his personnel from and against all liability in respect thereof and will be responsible for death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property and any other loss, damage, costs and expenses incurred as a result of the inspection.
- i. It is the sole responsibility of the bidders to regularly visit both the websites e-procurement website and NMRC's website www.nmrcnoida.com for all the latest information/updates.

3.1.5 Amendment of e-Bid Document

- a. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of e-Bid, NMRC may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the e-Bid document by amendments. Such amendments shall be uploaded on the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> or NMRC's website www.nmrcnoida.com. The relevant clauses of the e-Bid document shall be treated as amended accordingly.
- b. It shall be the sole responsibility of the prospective Bidder to check the web site <http://etender.up.nic.in> and NMRC's website www.nmrcnoida.com from time to time for any amendment in the e-Bid documents. In case of failure to get the amendments, if any, NMRC shall not be responsible for it.
- c. In order to allow prospective e-Bids a reasonable time to take the amendment into account in preparing their e-Bids, NMRC, at the discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of e-Bids. Such extensions shall be uploaded on the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> or NMRC's website www.nmrcnoida.com.

3.2 Preparation and submission of Bids

3.2.1 Language of e-Bid

The e-Bid prepared by the Bidder, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the e-Bid exchanged by the Bidder and NMRC shall be written in English language. Only English numerals shall be used in the e-Bid. The correspondence and documents in any other language must be accompanied by transcripts verified by the Embassy of Home Country or equivalent.

3.2.2 Documents constituting the e-Bid

The e-Bid prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following components:

- a. **Technical e-Bid- Technical e-Bid will comprise of-**
 - i. **Fee details** - Details of Bid processing fee and prescribed EMD
 - ii. **Eligibility details** - Includes copies of required documents in PDF format justifying that the Bidder is

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qualified to perform the contract if his/her bid is accepted and the Bidder has financial & technical capability necessary to perform the contract and meets the criteria outlined in the Qualification requirement and technical specification and fulfill all the conditions of the contract.

iii. **Technical evaluation** - Details of all documents needed for Technical evaluation as mentioned in this RFP

b. **Financial e-Bid** -

i. **Price bid** – Bill of Quantities in XLS format to be filled in after downloading from the e- Procurement website for this e-tender (<http://etender.up.nic.in>). There shall be a single financial quote for the package for which the bid is submitted.

3.2.3 Documents establishing Bidder's Qualification

- a. The Bidder shall furnish, as part of its technical e-Bid, documents establishing the Bidder's qualification to perform the contract if its e-Bid is accepted. The documentary evidence should be submitted by the Bidder electronically in the PDF format.
- b. The documentary evidence of Bidder's qualification to perform the contract if its e-Bid is accepted shall be as per qualification requirements specified in e-Bid document.
- c. The bidder is required to sign with stamp on each page of RFP Document.

3.2.4 E-Bid form

The Bidder shall complete the e-Bid form and the appropriate price schedule/BOQ furnished in the e-Bid document.

3.2.5 E-Bid Currency

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

3.2.6 Formats and Signing of e-Bid

- a. The Bidder shall prepare one electronic copy of the technical e-Bid and financial e-Bid separately.
- b. The e-Bid document shall be digitally signed, at the time of uploading, by the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the Bidder to the contract. The later authorization shall be indicated by a scanned copy of written power-of attorney accompanying the e-Bid. All the pages/documents of the e-Bid that are to be uploaded shall be digitally signed by the person authorized to sign the e-Bid.
- c. Bidders should provide all the information as per the RFP and in the specified formats. NMRC reserves the rights to reject any proposal that is not in the specified formats.
- d. In case the Bidders intends to provide additional information for which specified space in the given format is not sufficient, it can be furnished in duly stamped and signed PDFs.

3.2.7 Deadline for submission of e-Bid

E-Bid (Technical and financial) must be submitted by the Bidder at e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> not later than the time specified on the prescribed date (as the server time displayed in the e-procurement website). NMRC may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for submission of e-Bid by amending the e-Bid document, in which case all rights and obligations of NMRC and Bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

3.2.8 Submission of e-Bid

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- a. The bid submission module of e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> enables the Bidders to submit the e-Bid online in response to this e-Bid published by NMRC.
- b. Bid submission can be done only from the bid submission start date and time till the bid submission end date and time given in the e-Bid. Bidders should start the bid submission process well in advance so that they can submit their e-Bid in time.
- c. The Bidder should submit their e-Bid considering the server time displayed in the e-procurement website. This server time is the time by which the e-Bid submission activity will be allowed till the permissible time on the last/end date of submission indicated in the e-Bid schedule.
- d. Once the e-Bid submission date and time is over, the Bidders cannot submit their e-Bid. For delay in submission of e-Bid due to any reasons, the Bidders shall only be held responsible.

3.2.9 Instructions for Bidders

The Bidders have to follow the following instructions for submission of their e-Bid:

a. For participating in e-Bid through the e-Bidding system it is necessary for the Bidders to be the registered users of the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in>. The Bidders must obtain a user login Id and password by registering themselves with U.P. Electronics Corporation Ltd. Lucknow if they have not done so previously for registration.

b. In addition to the normal registration, the Bidder has to register with his/her digital signature certificate (DSC) in the e-Bidding system and subsequently he/she will be allowed to carry out his/her e-Bid submission activities. Registering the digital signature certificate (DSC) is a one-time activity. Before proceeding to register his/her DSC, the Bidder should first log on to the e-Bidding system using the user login option on the home page with the login Id and password with which he/she has registered.

For successful registration of DSC on e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> the Bidder must ensure that he/she should possess class-2/class-3 DSC issued by any certifying authorities approved by controller of certifying authorities, Government of India, as the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> is presently accepting DSC issued by these authorities only. The Bidder can obtain user login Id and perform DSC registration exercise given above even before the e-Bid submission date starts. NMRC shall not be held responsible if the Bidder tries to submit his/her e-Bid at the moment before end date of submission but could not submit due to DSC registration problem.

c. The Bidder can search for active Bids through "search active tenders" link, select a Bid in which he/she is interested in and then move it to 'My Tenders' folder using the options available in the e-Bid submission menu. After selecting and the Bid, for which the Bidder intends to e-Bid, from "My tenders" folder, the Bidder can place his/her e-Bid by clicking "pay offline" option available at the end of the view Bid details form. Before this, the Bidder should download the e-Bid document and price schedule/bill of quantity (BOQ) and study them carefully. The Bidder should keep all the documents ready as per the requirements of e-Bid document in the PDF format except the price schedule /bill of quantity (BOQ) which should be in the XLS format (excel sheet).

d. After clicking the 'pay offline' option, the Bidder will be redirected to terms and conditions page. The Bidder should read the terms & conditions before proceeding to fill in the Bid fee and EMD offline payment details. After entering and saving the Bid fee and EMD details form so that "bid document preparation and submission" window appears to upload the documents as per technical (fee details, qualification details, e-Bid form and technical specification details) and financial (e-Bid form and price schedule/BOQ) schedules/packets given in the Bid details. The details of the RTGS/NEFT should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the date entered during e-Bid submission time otherwise the e-Bid submitted will not be accepted.

e. Next the Bidder should upload the technical e-Bid documents for fee details (e-Bid fee and EMD), Qualification details. Before uploading, the Bidder has to select the relevant digital signature certificate. He may be prompted to enter the digital signature certificate password, if necessary. For uploading, the Bidder should click "browse" button against each document label in technical and financial schedules/packets and then upload the relevant PDF/XLS files already prepared and stored in the Bidder's computer.

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The required documents for each document label of technical (fee details, qualification details, e-Bid form and technical specification details) and financial (e-Bid form and price schedule/BOQ) schedules/packets can be clubbed together to make single different files for each label.

- f. The Bidder should click "Encrypt" next for successfully encrypting and uploading of required documents. during the above process, the e-Bid document are digitally signed using the DSC of the Bidder and then the documents are encrypted/locked electronically with the DSC's of the bid openers to ensure that the e-Bid documents are protected, stored and opened by concerned bid openers only.
- g. After successful submission of e-Bid document, a page giving the summary of e-Bid submission will be displayed confirming end of e-Bid submission process. 3.2.10 Late e-Bid

- a. Bids received by NMRC after the specified time on the Bid Due Date shall not be eligible for consideration and shall be summarily rejected.
- b. The server time indicated in the bid management window on the e- procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in> will be the time by which the e-Bid submission activity will be allowed till the permissible date and time scheduled in the e-Bid.
- c. Once the e-Bid submission date and time is over, the Bidder cannot submit his/her e-Bid. Bidder has to start the bid submission well in advance so that the submission process passes off smoothly. The Bidder will only be held responsible if his/her e-Bid is not submitted in time due to any of his/her problems/faults, for whatsoever reason, during e-Bid submission process.

3.2.11 Withdrawal and re-submission of e-Bid

- a. At any point of time, a Bidder can withdraw his/her e-Bid submitted online before the bid submission end date and time. For withdrawing the Bidder should first log in using his/her login id and password and subsequently by his/her digital signature certificate on the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in>. The Bidder should then select "My bids" option in the bid submission menu. The page listing all the bids submitted by the Bidder will be displayed. Click "View" to see the details of the bid to be withdrawn. After selecting the "bid withdrawal" option the Bidder has to click "Yes" to the message "Do you want to withdraw this bid?" displayed in the bid information window for the selected bid. The Bidder also has to enter the bid withdrawing reasons and upload the letter giving the reasons for withdrawing before clicking the "Submit" button. The Bidder has to confirm again by pressing "OK" button before finally withdrawing his/her selected e-Bid.
- b. No e-Bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of e-Bids and the expiration of period of e- bid validity. Withdrawal of an e-Bid during this interval may result in the forfeiting of Bidder's e-Bid security.
- c. The Bidder can re-submit his/her e-Bid as when required till the e-Bid submission end date and time. The e-Bid submitted earlier will be replaced by the new one. The payment made by the Bidder earlier will be used for revised e-Bid and the new e-Bid submission summary generated after the successful submission of the revised e-Bid will considered for evaluation purposes. For re-submission, the Bidder should first log in using his/her login Id and password and subsequently by his/her digital signature certificate on the e-procurement website <http://etender.up.nic.in>. The Bidder should then select "My bids" option in the bid submission menu. The page listing all the submitted by the Bidder will be displayed. Click "View" to see the detail of the e-Bid to be resubmitted. After selecting the "bid re-submission" option, click "Encrypt & upload" to upload the revised e-Bids documents.
- d. The Bidder can submit their revised e-Bids as many times as possible by uploading their e-Bid documents within the scheduled date & time for submission of e-Bids.

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- e. No e-Bid can be resubmitted subsequently after the deadline for submission of e-Bids.

3.2.12 NMRC's right to accept any e-Bid and to reject any or all e-Bids.

- a. Notwithstanding anything contained in this e-Bid, NMRC reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid and to annul the Selection Process and reject all Bids, at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof.
- b. NMRC reserves the right to reject any Bid if:
 - At any time, a material misrepresentation is made or uncovered, or
 - The Bidder does not provide, within the time specified by NMRC, the supplemental information sought by NMRC for evaluation of the Bid.
- c. Such misrepresentation/ improper response may lead to the disqualification of the Bidder. If such disqualification /rejection occurs after the e-Bid have been opened and the highest ranking Bidder gets disqualified / rejected, then the NMRC reserves the right to consider the next best Bidder, or take any other measure as may be deemed fit in the sole discretion of NMRC, including annulment of the Selection Process.

3.2.13 Period of validity of e-Bid

- a. e-Bid shall remain valid for 180 days after the date of e-Bid opening prescribed by NMRC. An e-Bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by NMRC as non-responsive.
- b. In exceptional circumstances, NMRC may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of e-Bid validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing.

3.2.14 Correspondence with the Bidder

- a. Save and except as provided in this e-Bid, NMRC shall not entertain any correspondence with any Bidder or its Technical Partners in relation to acceptance or rejection of any e-Bid.
- b. No Bidders or its Technical Partners shall contact NMRC on any matter relating to his e-Bid from the time of Bid opening to the time contract is awarded.
- c. Any effort by the Bidder or by its Technical Partners to influence NMRC in the Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or contract award decisions, may result in the rejection of his Bid.

3.3 Earnest Money Deposit

3.3.1 Earnest money deposit(EMD)

- a. The tenderer shall furnish, as part of its e-Bid, an e-Bid security/ EMD as stated in Data Sheet, **Rs. 107050/- (Rs. One Lakh Seven Thousand Fifty Only)**, in form of RTGS/NEFT only in favour Noida Metro Rail Corporation Limited in the A/c No. mentioned in **Data Sheet**. The scanned copy of RTGS/NEFT receipt of Security/ EMD with transaction Id certified by the same bank must be enclosed along with the e-Bid. Tender without Earnest Money in the prescribed form, will not be accepted.
- b. Bidders submitting bids for more than one package shall be required to submit EMD for each package as mentioned in **Data Sheet** for which bid is submitted.
- c. Any e-Bid not secured in accordance with above shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected by NMRC.
- d. Unsuccessful Bidder's EMD will be returned after conclusion or discharge of the tender.
- e. No interest will be paid by the Purchaser on the Earnest Money Deposit.
- f. The successful Bidder's e-Bid EMD will be adjusted with Performance Bank Guarantee, if applicable, to be submitted by the Bidder upon signing the contract.

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- g. The EMD may be forfeited:
 - i. If Bidder (a) withdraws its e-Bid during the period of e-Bid validity specified by the Bidder on the e- bid form: or (b) does not accept the correction of errors or (c) modifies its e-Bid price during the period of e-Bid validity specified by the Bidder on the form.
 - ii. In case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails to sign the contract with the Corporation.
- h. Tender Cost and EMD is exempted for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with District Industries Centre or Khadi & Village Industries Commission or Khadi & Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Dte. Of Handicraft & Handloom or any other bodies specified by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises for appropriate category and have valid registration certificate as on date of tender submission. NMRC will follow all government notification related to tender, EMD, PBG as required from time to time.

The MSEs would not be eligible for exemption of EMD if:

- a. Either they are not registered for appropriate category.
- b. Or they do not have valid registration as on the date of tender submission.

The tenderers seeking exemption from 'EMD', being MSEs, shall ensure their eligibility w.r.t above and submit registration certificate issued by the body under which they are registered which clearly mentions category of registration i.e. **"Repair of communication equipment"** and Terminal Validity of registration.

3.4 Opening and Evaluation of Bids

During Evaluation, if required NMRC can seek clarification from bidders for the bid document submitted only. No fresh supporting document will be entertained.

3.4.1 Opening of technical e-Bid by NMRC

- a. NMRC will open all technical e-Bids, in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend on the prescribed date of opening at NMRC Office. The Bidder's representatives who are present shall submit the letter to NMRC on the letter head of the company stating that the representative (name) is authorized to attend the meeting (Please note – The representative is required to carry a copy during pre-bid and other related meetings as well). He / She shall sign a register evidencing their attendance at NMRC. In the event of the specified date e-Bid opening being declared a holiday for the Corporation, the e –bids shall be opened at the appointed time and place on the next working day.
- b. The Bidder who is participating in e-Bid should ensure that the RTGS/NEFT of Bid Processing Fee and EMD must be submitted in the prescribed account of NMRC within the duration (strictly within opening & closing date and time of individual e-Bid) of the work as mentioned in Bid notice, otherwise, in any case, e-Bid shall be rejected.
- c. The Bidders names and the presence or absence of requisite e-Bid security and such other details as NMRC at its discretion may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening.

3.4.2 Opening of financial e-Bid

- a. After evaluation of technical e-Bid, through the evaluation committee NMRC shall notify those Bidders whose technical e-Bids were considered non-responsive to the conditions of the contract and not meeting the technical specifications and qualification requirements indicating that their financial e-Bids will not be opened.
- b. NMRC will simultaneously notify the Bidders, whose technical e-Bids were considered acceptable to the Corporation. The notification may sent by e-mail provided by Bidder.

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c. The financial e-Bids of technically qualified Bidders shall be opened in the presence of technically qualified bidders who choose to attend. The date and time for opening of financial bids will be communicated to the technically qualified Bidders subsequently after completion of technical bids evaluation through e-mail provided by the Bidder.

3.4.3 Correction of Errors

d. Financial Bids determined to be responsive will be checked by NMRC for any arithmetic errors. Where there is a discrepancy between the rate quoted in the Financial Bid, in figures and in words, the amount in words will prevail over the amounts in figures, to the extent of such discrepancy.

e. The amount stated in the Financial Bid will be adjusted by NMRC in accordance with the above procedure for the correction of errors and shall be considered as binding upon the Bidder. If the Bidder does not accept the corrected quoted rate of e-Bid, his e-Bid will be rejected, and his Bid Security shall be liable for forfeiture.

3.4.4 Examination of e-Bid document

a. The NMRC will examine the e-Bid to determine if:

- i. They are complete;
- ii. They meet all the conditions of the contract;
- iii. The required e-Bid Processing fee, EMD and other required documents have been furnished;
- iv. The documents have been properly digitally signed; and
- v. The e-Bids are in order.

b. Any e-Bid or e-Bids not fulfilling these requirements shall be rejected.

3.4.5 Contacting NMRC

a. No Bidder shall contact NMRC on any matter relating to his/her e-Bid, from the time of the e-Bid opening to the time the contract is awarded. If the Bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of NMRC, he/she can do so in writing.

b. Any effort by a Bidder to influence NMRC in its decisions on e-Bid evaluation, e- bid comparison or contract award may result in rejection of the Bidder's e-Bid.

c. In the event of any information furnished by the Bidder is found false or fabricated, the minimum punishment shall be debarring /blacklisting from Noida Metro works and legal proceeding can also be initiated. EMD of such bidders will be

d. forfeited.

e. NMRC during bid evaluation, if so required, may contact participating bidders for further clarifications on bid documents submitted.

3.4.6 Confidentiality

a. Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation, and recommendation for the Bidders shall not be disclosed to any person who is not officially concerned with the process or is not a retained professional advisor advising NMRC in relation to or matters arising out of, or concerning the Bidding Process. Any effort by a Bidder to exert undue or unfair influence in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Proposal shall result in outright rejection of the offer, made by the said Bidder.

b. NMRC shall treat all information, submitted as part of Bid, in confidence and shall require all those who have access to such material to treat the same in confidence. NMRC may not divulge

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any such information unless it is directed to do so by any statutory entity that has the power under law to require its disclosure or is to enforce or assert any right or privilege of the statutory entity and/ or NMRC or as may be required by law or in connection with any legal process.

3.5 Award of Contract

3.5.1 Award Criteria

- a. NMRC will award the contract as per evaluation criteria stated in the RFP Document.
- b. NMRC will award the contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be responsive to all the conditions of the contract and meeting the eligibility requirement of the bidding document.

3.5.2 Notice of Award (NOA)

- a. Prior to the expiration of the period of e-Bid validity, NMRC will notify the successful Bidder in writing, by letter/e-mail/fax, that its e-Bid has been accepted.
- b. The acceptance of NOA will constitute the formation of the contract.

3.5.3 Signing of contract

At the same time as NMRC notifies the successful Bidder that its e-Bid has been accepted, the successful Bidder shall have to sign the Agreement with relevant document as mentioned in the RFP. The agreement draft along with other related terms and conditions will be same as furnished in this e-Bid. Any refusal will not be allowed. The Bidder need not download and submit in hard copies of these documents. Contractor is required to sign the contract agreement within 45 days of acceptance by the successful bidder.

3.5.4 NMRC's right to accept any e-Bid and to reject any or all e-Bids

NMRC reserves the right to accept or reject any e-Bid, and to annul the e-Bid process and reject all e- Bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected tenderer or tenderers.

Signing of contracts need to be completed within 45 days of acceptance by the successful bidder.

Section 4: Eligibility, Evaluation and Selection Process

4.1 Eligibility Criteria

The Bidder's competence and capability is proposed to be established by the following parameters. The Bidder should meet all the criteria given in this section.

- a. Sole proprietorship, registered partnership firm (including LLP), public limited company or private limited company can submit the Bidder. The firms and the companies should be registered in India and office should be in Delhi NCR.
- b. The Bidder should have a minimum experience of having satisfactorily and successfully completed similar works during last 7 (Seven) years period ending last day of month previous to the one in which the bids are invited should be either of the following:
 - i. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to .Rs.85,63,968.00 (Rs. Eighty Five Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Eight only) or
 - ii. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 53,52,480.00 (Rs. Fifty Three Lakh Fifty Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty only) or
 - iii. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. Rs. 42,81,984.00 (Rs. Forty Two Lakh Eighty One Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Four Only)
 - iv.

Definition of Similar Works—work involving supply, installation, testing and commissioning/ AMC/CAMC/Upgradation of Video Screen system (Preferably Large Video Screens) in Railways, Metro Railways, Airports and other Govt./PSU organizations.

- c. The Bidder should have minimum Average Annual Turnover from similar work of Rs.85,63,968.00 (Rs. Eighty Five Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Eight only) in the last 5 (Five) Financial Years (2017-2018,2018-19,2019-20,2020-21,2021-22) preceding the Bid Due Date.
- d. Working capital/Net cash flow(Current asset minus current liabilities should be greater than Rs. 5,09,760/- (Rupees Five Lakh Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Only) in the last audited F.Y.
- e. Net worth should be greater than Rs. 7, 13,664/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Four only) in the last audited F.Y.
- f. The Bidder should be registered with the Goods and Services Tax Authorities.
- g. The Bidder should not have been blacklisted/ banned/ declared ineligible for corrupt and fraudulent practices by the Government of India/ any State Government/ Government Agency and court of law and contracts have been terminated/ foreclosed by any company / department due to non- fulfillment of Contractual obligation in last 5 (five) financial years.
- h. Profit before tax should be positive in at least 2 (Two) years; out of the last 5 (Five) audited financial years.
- i. All bidders must submit OEM authorization form (as per format given in Form 13) in the bid, without which the bid will be summarily rejected.

The Bidder shall also furnish the following documentary proof:

- a. For above criteria 4.1a
 - i. Registration certificate of the firm/ Partnership deed/ certificate of incorporation,etc.
- b. For above criteria 4.1b

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- i. Form 4: Work Experience with documentary evidence
- c. For above criteria 4.1 c & h
 - i. Form 5: Financial Capability Details
 - ii. A copy of the Audited balance sheets and Profit and Loss Statements for the last 5 (Five) financial years
In case the Financial Statements for the latest financial year are not audited and therefore the Bidder cannot make it available, the Bidder shall give an undertaking to this effect and the statutory auditor/charted accountant shall certify the same. In such a case, the Bidder shall provide the Audited Financial Statements for 4 (Four) years preceding the year for which the Audited Financial Statement is not being provided. Also, pertaining to latest financial year, the bidder shall submit an affidavit certifying that "The Annual Accounts have not been audited so far. We are submitting the CA certified provisional accounts, which shall be substantiated by the Audited Accounts, when prepared." Bidders must submit the work order copies along with Satisfactory Work Completion Certificates. In case of on going work, the partial completion value pertaining to current year will be considered.
 - iii. Self attested copy of PAN, ITR for latest five financial year.
- d. For above criteria 4.1 f
 - i. Copy of GST registration certificate
- e. For above criteria 4.1 g
 - i. Form 7: Undertaking

4.2 Information of the Technical and Financial Proposal

- a. The financial proposal of only technically qualified Bidders shall be opened for evaluation.
- b. The Bidder satisfying the criteria under shall be considered as qualified.
- c. The financial proposal of only qualified Bidders shall be opened for evaluation.
- d. The Bidder with the lowest quoted price for the entire term of 03 years in the financial quote (L1 bidder) shall be selected for the award of contract.

4.2.1 Selection of Bidder

NMRC shall award the Contract for **CAMC of LVS System in NMRC** to the Lowest Tenderer (L1 bidder), whose tender has been determined to be substantially responsive and compliant to the requirements contained in the Tender Documents.

- a. In case, two or more technically qualified bidders quote the same rate
- b. in the Commercial Bid, and become Lowest (i.e. L-1), then the tender would be awarded to the bidder who has the highest / higher Average Annual Turnover from 'Similar Works' (as per Minimum Eligibility Criteria defined in Section 4 under "Definition of Similar Work") during the last 5 years ending on the last day of the month preceding the month in which the tender has been floated. Experience certificate / work completion certificate on client's letter head is mandatory to ascertain the nature, period and value of work which shall be required to be uploaded by the bidder by the last date of tender submission.
- c. Prior to the expiry of the period of bid validity, NMRC will notify the successful bidder in writing, either through Notice of Award (NOA), that his bid has been accepted.
- d. The NOA would be sent in duplicate to the successful bidder, who will return one copy to NMRC duly acknowledged, signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidder, as an

unconditional acceptance of the NOA, within 10 (ten) days from the date of issue of NOA.

e. In the event that 2 (two) or more technically qualified Bidders have submitted the lowest identical Price Bids, will be called "Tie Bidders" and Case will be termed as Tie. NMRC shall hold an auction amongst such Tie Bidders. The auction shall be held at the offices of NMRC and only the Tie Bidders shall be invited to attend the same, wherein they have to physically submit their revised Price Bids on their letterhead (with company rubber stamp) and in sealed covers. Hence the Authorized Signatory of the Tie Bidders are required to attend such auction. The revised Price Bid (the "Revised Price Bid") submitted by a Tie Bidder during the auction should be lower than Price Bid already submitted by it, else the revised Price Bid shall not be considered by NMRC for further evaluation. The Tie Bidder who offers the lowest revised Price Bid in such auction shall be declared to be Selected Bidder and the lowest revised Price Bid received by NMRC during such auction shall be the L1 price. In the event that the Authorized Signatory of a Tie Bidder is not present during the auction or the Authorized Signatory of such Bidder does not or is unwilling to participate in such auction, the auction would be held amongst the remaining Tie Bidders and if there be only one remaining Tie Bidder, the latter will be declared as the Selected Bidder, provided that the revised Price Bid submitted by such Bidder is lower than that its earlier submitted Price Bid; in such as case the revised Price Bid submitted by such Bidder shall be considered to be the L1 price. In case of a second round of tie between the revised Price Bids submitted by the Tie Bidders, the Bidder with the higher average annual turnover (to be determined by NMRC on the basis of the audited financial statements submitted by such Bidders as part of their Techno-Commercials Bids) in the last 5 (Five) financial years shall be declared as the Selected Bidder and the L1 price shall be the revised Price Bid submitted by such Bidder during the auction.

f. No correspondence will be entertained by NMRC from the unsuccessful bidders.

4.3 Notice of Award and Execution of Contract Agreement

- a. NMRC will notify the Successful Bidder by a NOA that its bid has been accepted.
- b. The Selected Bidder shall, within 10 (ten) days of the receipt of the NOA, sign and return the duplicate copy of the NOA in acknowledgement thereof along with letter of acceptance of NOA. In the event, the duplicate copy of the NOA duly signed by the Selected Bidder and letter of acceptance of NOA is not received by the stipulated date, NMRC may, unless it consents to extension of time for submission thereof, appropriate the Bid Security of such Bidder as mutually agreed genuine pre-estimated loss and damage suffered by NMRC on account of failure of the Selected Bidder to acknowledge the NOA
- c. The Successful Bidder shall execute the Contract Agreement within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of acceptance of Notice of Award (NOA) or such extended period as may be decided by the Corporation.
- d. Failure of the Successful Bidder to comply with the requirement of acknowledgement of NOA shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the NOA, and forfeiture of the bid security. **The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity up to 25% of the quantity offered by the successful tenderer. The bidder is bound to accept the increase or decrease in the tendered quantity up to 25% under this clause without any change in unit price.**

4.4 Performance Bank Guarantee / Security Deposit

- a. To fulfill the requirement of performance bank guarantee during the implementation period, the Successful Bidder (herein referred to as the "Contractor") shall deposit 3% of the Contract Price in form of FDR/ DD or unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee bond issued by a scheduled bank whose branch is situated in Delhi NCR/Noida (issued form Delhi NCR/Noida Branch) in favor of Noida Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. valid for 42 months within 30 days from the date of acceptance of Notice of Award. EMD amount of successful bidder shall be adjusted in the performance bank guarantee, if applicable. For unsuccessful bidder, EMD shall be refunded without any interest. In case

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of extension of tenure by 6 months, the performance bank guarantee shall be extended by 6 months as well. "All government guidelines regarding PBD shall prevail".

b. It is to note that if contract value increases by more than 25% of the original contract value, the performance bank guarantee shall be increased accordingly.

c. A Contract agreement will have to be signed by the Contractor at his cost on proper stamp paper. Without performance guarantee by Contractor, Contract agreement shall not be signed.

d. NMRC reserves the right for deduction of NMRC dues from Contractor's Performance Bank Guarantee/ Security Deposit (interest free) for – Any penalty imposed by NMRC for violation of any terms and conditions of agreement committed by the Contractor.

i. Any amount which NMRC becomes liable to the Government/Third party due to any default of the Contractor or any of his director/ employees/ representatives/ servant/ agent,etc.

ii. Any payment/ fine made under the order/judgment of any court/consumer forum or law enforcing Contractor or any person duly empowered in his behalf.

iii. Any outstanding payment/ claims of NMRC remained due after completion of relevant actions as per agreement.

iv. Any financial impact on NMRC due to non-performance of contractor.

Once the amount under above Clause is debited, the Contractor shall replenish the Security Deposit/ Performance Bank Guarantee to the extent the amount is debited within 30 days period, Failing which, it shall be treated as Contractor Event of Default and will entitle NMRC to deal with the matter as per the provisions of RFP and Contract Agreement. In case of BG encashment, contract will stand terminated.

e. PBG must be submitted in the format provided in Form 14. PBG must be in Favour of Noida Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. issued by Schedule bank of Delhi/NCR/Noida Branch. Validity of PBG is 3 years and six months from the date of acceptance of NOA (Notice of Award).

4.5 Contract during Proposal Evaluation

a. Proposals shall be deemed to be under consideration immediately after they are opened and until such time NMRC makes official intimation of award/ rejection to the Bidders. While the Proposals are under consideration, Bidders and/ or their representatives or other interested parties are advised to refrain from contacting by any means, NMRC and/ or their employees/ representatives on matters related to the Proposals under consideration till the time Contract is awarded

b. Any effort by a Bidder to influence NMRC in its decisions on e-Bid evaluation, e-Bid comparison or contract award may result in rejection of the Bidder's e-Bid.

c. In the event of any information furnished by the agency is found false or fabricated the minimum punishment shall be debarred/ blacklisting and the legal proceeding may also be initiated.

d. If the Bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of NMRC, he/she can do so in writing. All correspondence/ enquiry should be submitted to the following in writing by fax/ post/courier:

4.6 Project Financial Terms

Payment Terms

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The standard payment terms subject to recoveries, if any by way of Liquidated damages (LD) will be as under:

- a. For the purpose of on account payment, contractor shall submit detailed activities carried out as per Book Of Quantity (BOQ) along with quoted bill for the items actually executed and work completion certificate duly verified by the Site Engineer of NMRC for checking and payments.
- b. Payment will be effected based on unit rate as approved in the Book Of Quantity (BOQ).
- c. The payment shall be made on monthly basis for the activities as per the actual quantity with in scope of work
- d. No Payment shall be made in advance.

Section 5: General Conditions of Contract (GCC)

These conditions shall be part of the contract agreement.

5.1 General Provisions

5.1.1 Governing law and jurisdiction

These general conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws in the territory of India. Irrespective of the place of delivery and the place of payment under the contract, the contract shall be deemed to have been made at the place in India from where the acceptance of tender has been issued. Any dispute arising between the parties or arising out of this project or these terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of, and venue in, the District court located in Gautam Buddh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, India.

5.1.2 Notices

Any notice, request or consent required or permitted to be given or made pursuant to these general conditions shall be in writing. Any such notice, request or consent shall be deemed to have been given or made when delivered in person to an authorized representative of the party to whom the communication is addressed, or when sent to such party at the mentioned address.

5.1.3 Authorized Representatives

Any action required or permitted to be taken, and any document required or permitted to be executed under these general conditions by the Corporation or the Successful Bidder may be taken or executed by the officials as formally designated by each party.

5.1.4 Taxes and Duties

- a. The Agency shall bear and pay all taxes, duties, levies and charges assessed on the Agency, its Sub Agencies or their employees by all municipal, state or national government authorities in connection with the Facilities in and outside India, the amount of which is deemed to have been included in the Contract Price.
- b. The Agency shall ensure full compliance with tax laws of India with regard to this contract and shall be solely responsible for the same. He shall keep the Employer fully indemnified against liability of tax, interest, penalty etc., of the Agency's in respect thereof, which may arise.

5.2 Commencement, Completion, Modification and Termination of Contract

5.2.1 Effectiveness of Contract

This Contract shall come into effect on the date the Contract is signed by both the parties and such other later date as discussed and agreed with the Bidder.

5.2.2 Commencement of Services

The Agency shall begin carrying out the Services from the date of acceptance of NOA or any such date as specified by the Corporation.

5.2.3 Expiration of Contract

Unless terminated earlier pursuant to Clause 5.2.6 hereof, these general conditions shall expire at the end of such time period as given in the time schedule in RFP Document.

5.2.4 Modifications or Variations

Any modification or variation of the terms and conditions of these general terms, including any modification or variation of the scope of the Services, may only be made by written agreement between the Parties. However, each Party shall give due consideration to any proposals for modification or variation made by the other Party.

5.2.5 Force Majeure

- (i) Definition: For the purpose of these general terms, "Force Majeure" means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of a Party and which makes a Party's performance of its obligations under the Contract impossible or so impractical as to be considered impossible under the circumstances.
- (ii) No Breach of Contract: The failure of a Party to fulfill any of its obligations under the contract shall not be considered to be a breach of, or default under, this Contract insofar as such inability arises from an event of Force Majeure, provided that the Party affected by such an event (a) has taken all reasonable precautions, due care and reasonable alternative measures in order to carry out the terms and conditions of this Contract, and (b) has informed the other Party as soon as possible about the occurrence of such an event.
- (iii) Extension of Time: Any period within which a Party shall, pursuant to this Contract, complete any action or task, shall be extended for a period equal to the time during which such Party was unable to perform such action as a result of Force Majeure.
- (iv) Payments: During the period of their inability to perform the Services as a result of an event of Force Majeure, the Agency shall be entitled for time extension for such period.
- (v) Conditions like Pandemic/Lockdown (e.g. in COVID-19) will be treated as Force Majeure. During the period of Non-performance in these conditions, contractor will not be billed and Extension of Time will be given for such period.

5.2.6 Termination of Contract

If the Agency fails to deliver the items within the period fixed for such delivery in the contract or as extended or at any time repudiates the contract before the expiry of such period, the purchaser may without prejudice to his other rights. The total amount of liquidated damages, however, not exceed the **limit of liquidated damages i.e.10 % of total CAMC value**, after which contract will be deemed as cancelled & PBG will be encashed by the Purchaser.

5.2.7. Upon Termination of this Agreement for any reason whatsoever

The termination of this Agreement shall not release Agency to pay any sums then owing to the other party nor from the obligation to perform or discharge any liability that had been incurred prior thereto.

5.3 Insolvency and Breach of Contract

The Purchaser may at any time, issue notice in writing summarily terminate the contract without compensation to the Agency in any of the following events, that is to say –

- a. If the Agency being an individual or a firm - Any partner thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order or order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any conveyance or assignment of his effects or enter into any assignment or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm be dissolved under the Partnership Act, or
- b. If the Agency being a company is wound up voluntarily or by the order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator, or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders is appointed, or circumstances shall have arisen which entitle the Court or Debenture holders to appoint a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager, or
- c. If the Agency commits any breach of the contract not herein specifically provided for
- d. Provided always that such determination shall not prejudice any right of action or remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to the Purchaser and provided also the Agency shall be liable to pay

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to the Purchaser any extra expenditure he is thereby put to and the Agency shall, under no circumstances, be entitled to any gain on re purchase.

5.4 Warranty

- a. The Bidder shall give warranty that the goods shall be new and free from defects and manufacture shall be of the highest grade and consistent with the established and generally accepted standards for materials of the type ordered.
- b. Warranty of replaced equipment should be of at least 90 days.
- c. If it becomes necessary for the Agency to replace or renew any defective portion/portions of the item under this clause, the provisions of the clause shall apply to the portion/portions of item's replaced or renewed. If any defect is not remedied within a reasonable time, the Purchaser may proceed to get the work done at the Agency's risk and expenses, but without prejudice to any other rights which the Purchaser may have against the Agency in respect of such defects.
- d. Replacement under warranty clause shall be made by the Agency free of all charges at site including freight, insurance and other incidental charges, as the case may be.

5.5 Inspection

The Purchaser or its representatives or ultimate client shall have the right to inspect and test the goods for their conformity to the specifications as required.

5.6 Obligations of the Agency

- a. The Agency/Bidder shall undertake **CAMC of LVS System in NMRC** with due care and diligence in accordance with the Contract.
- b. Engagement of Staff and Labour- Except as otherwise stated in the Specification, the Agency shall ensure/ make arrangements for the engagement of all staff and labour, local or otherwise, and for their payment, transport, etc.

5.7 Packaging

The Agency shall be responsible for packing, transporting, receiving, storing and protecting all items and other things required for the Works.

5.8 Obligations of Corporation

NMRC agrees to provide support to the Agency and undertake to observe, comply with and perform, subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement and the Applicable Laws.

5.9 Fraud and Corrupt Practices

- a. The Bidders and their respective officers, employees, agents and advisers shall observe highest standard of ethics during Bidding Process and subsequent to issue of NOA and during subsistence of Contract Agreement. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, or in the NOA or the Contract Agreement, NMRC may reject a Bid, withdraw the NOA, or terminate the Contract Agreement, as the case may be, without being liable in any manner whatsoever to the Bidder or Agency, as the case may be, if it determines that the Bidder or Agency, as the case may be, has, directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice in the Bidding Process. In such an event, NMRC shall be entitled to forfeit & appropriate Bid Security or Security Deposit (interest free)/ Performance Bank Guarantee, as the case may be, as Damages, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to NMRC under Bidding Documents and/ or Contract Agreement, or otherwise.
- b. Without prejudice to the rights of NMRC under Clause 5.9 a hereinabove and the rights and remedies which NMRC may have under the NOA or the Contract Agreement, or otherwise if a Bidder or Agency, as the case may be, is found by NMRC to have directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged or

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indulged in any corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice during the Bidding Process, or after the issue of the NOA or the execution of the Contract Agreement, such Bidder or Agency shall not be eligible to participate in any tender or RFP issued by NMRC during a period of 3 (three) years from the date such Bidder is found by NMRC to have engaged, directly or indirectly, in any corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice.

c. For the purposes of this Clause, the following terms shall have the meaning herein after respectively assigned to them:

- i. "corrupt practice" means the offering, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the selection process or in contract execution;
- ii. "fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to influence a selection process or the execution of a contract;
- iii. "collusive practices" means a scheme or arrangement between the Agency, with or without the knowledge of the authority, designed to establish prices at artificial, non-competitive levels;
- iv. "coercive practices" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process, or affect the execution of a contract

d. Measures to be taken:

- i. The Corporation shall have right to cancel the engagement of the Agency, if found to be indulged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices either during the selection process or during the execution of the contract.

5.10 Settlement of Disputes

5.10.1. Amicable Settlement

The Parties agree that the avoidance or early resolution of disputes is crucial for a smooth execution of the Contract and the success of the Project. The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this Contract or its interpretation.

5.10.2. Arbitration

In the event of any dispute and/ or difference whatsoever arising under this contract or in connection therewith, including any question relating to the meaning, scope and interpretation of this Contract or it's clause or any alleged breach thereof, the same shall be attempted to be settled by mutual discussions and consultations between the parties hereof. In the event of any such dispute, any/ or difference is not settled in aforesaid manner, then the dispute(s) shall be referred for arbitration. The sole Arbitrator would be appointed by the MD, NMRC. The decision of the said sole Arbitrator shall be final subject to the above, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply. The arbitration proceedings shall take place in Noida.

5.10.3. Jurisdiction

With respect to any dispute arising out of or related to this Contract, the parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of, and venue in, the District Court located in Gautam Buddh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, India.

5.10.4. Cost

The cost of arbitration shall be borne by the respective parties. The cost shall, inter alia, include the fees of the Arbitrator(s) as per rates fixed by the Employer from time to time.
