

Aqua Line service every 7 minutes during rush hour

Aqua Line Metro trains will be available every 7.30 minutes during rush hours and every 10th minute during non-rush hours on weekdays from June 3, its operator, Noida Metro Rail Corporation (NMRC), announced on Saturday.

At present, the trains ply at an interval of 10 minutes during peak hours (8.00 am-11.00 pm and 5.00 pm-8.00 pm) and 15 minutes during non-peak hours from Monday to Friday, the NMRC said.

"NMRC will be increasing the frequency of the Metro trains on the Aqua Line on weekdays with effect from June 3 (Monday). Trains on the Aqua Line will now ply at a frequency of 7 minutes 30 seconds during peak
