

# NMRC TO HOLD SMART CARD CAMP FOR NSEZ EMPLOYEES

**NOIDA:** The Noida Metro Rail Corporation (NMRC) will organise a special camp to issue Smart Cards exclusively to Noida Special Economic Zone (NSEZ) employees and entrepreneurs on May 24.

The programme will be held by NMRC in collaboration with the State Bank of India (SBI).

Officials from both NMRC and SBI will be deployed at the NSEZ Metro station to ensure the smooth issuing of the cards. Alok Tandon, managing director of NMRC, had directed the officials to organise the programme as a follow-up to the interactive session held with the NSEZ employees that was organised on May 15.

NMRC said it records movement of over 17,000 commuters every day on the Aqua Line that connects Noida Sector 51 to Depot Station in Greater Noida.

P D Upadhyay, executive director, NMRC said that representatives of around 40 companies had participated in the May 15 event and in their feedback had asked for the provision of Smart Cards for the employees.

NMRC has built a dedicated station near the NSEZ campus and also constructed a foot over-bridge from the station to NSEZ Campus to facilitate commuters' movement.
