### The measures taken by NDMC are enumerated below:

#### A. Operations and frequency

1. Initially for a few days, 15 mins frequency of trains will be maintained throughout the week (Monday to Friday).
2. The trend of the riding will be analysed and any change due to demands of residential area frequency will be decided accordingly.
3. Stations falling in residential areas shall remain closed and trains will not stop there unless such changes be allowed to the commuters through public notice, assessment and updates the NDMC website and application.

#### B. Cleaning and sanitisation of trains and stations

1. Intensive cleaning and sanitisation of station areas and the trains as a whole including public area, operational areas, waiting, push handles and poles, seats, doors, CCTV cameras, fare gates, escalators, handrails, etc. will be carried out in night fasting non-traffic hours and after each week night till 10th of the next month. Regular cleaning and sanitisation of the trains and the station areas will be done daily every day even during the lockdown period as the same practice will continue after the commencement of operations also.
2. Passenger contact areas such as call buttons of lifts, A/C pipes, handrails of escalators & stairs, etc. will be disinfected at intervals will be maintained as per protocol of every 2 hours daily.

#### C. Passenger screening and other guidelines to be followed at the stations

1. To travel in the metro, commuters will have to follow the following conditions:
  - \* Only the passengers with their masks covered will be allowed.
  - \* Every passenger will be screened by Thermal scanner.
  - \* The boarding temperature for travel permission will be as 37.7 degree centigrade.
  - \* Passengers having 'Aarogya Setu' app with safe status will only be allowed.
  - \* Passengers carrying NDMC pass will have to apply hand sanitizer which will be made available after screening of the person.
2. Passengers boarding train will be at a distance level before boarding by NDMC to ensure all the above guidelines for the passengers are being complied.
3. Only in urgent requirement cases, masks will be made available at the station.
4. Sanitizers will be provided for passengers at the Station level, at the TDM counter and at the ATD after use of the POC Machine. Availability of these sanitizers will be ensured at the metro station, staff and passengers will be encouraged to wash the hands in washrooms.
5. To ensure adequate Social Distancing, passengers will be advised to stand in a queue at designated spots for valid boarding in a queue of boarding zone. TDM counters, Platforms and inside the train.
6. Commuters should maintain at least 18 cms gap between the A/C Seats and Boarding Gate. QR code is mandatory to be used at the A/C gates.
7. On re-boarding, a gap of at least two steps should be maintained between two users.
8. Generally all lifts will be closed. However, in case of a request for some citizens & severely challenged passengers, the lift will be made available. Maximum of 4 persons shall use the lift in one time, passengers should stand facing the wall panels of the lift to prevent face-to-face interaction.
9. Digital payments will be preferred, instead of currency notes, by using mobile payments in the form of POC. Use of smart card (DMCCV NDMC) App instead of the token will be encouraged.
10. In case of doubt regarding any person having fever/symptoms/ symptoms, the concerned person will not be allowed entry in station premises and they will be given proper assistance for seeking further medical help.
11. In case of suspected passenger or baggage, two Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) suits of each station will be made available for the concerned staff deployed at the station.



#### D. Guidelines for travelling inside the trains

1. Passengers should not sit on the marked seats.
2. If required to travel on standing, the adequate distance by way of marking spaces the seats must be maintained.
3. Instructions will be displayed at the Platforms to allow to board the passengers first and thereafter only to board the train maintaining adequate distance will be displayed.
4. The crowd inside the train, as well as the station platform, will be monitored through CCTV from OCC/CC/Control/Office in special A/C. If there is crowd or overcrowded, entry of the train will be stopped through the emergency door.
5. In case of emergency, stoppage at the station, having train control and be deployed after making an announcement inside the train by Train Operator and at the station by Station Controller.
6. Sufficient number of security personnel will be deployed at the station and will be deployed at every station to ensure proper crowd control, monitoring and proper management.
7. Personnel will be placed regularly to ensure train boarding any surface inside the metro station or train.

#### E. Entry and exit at stations

1. If the stations having less footfall and not requiring the facility to cross the emergency door by NDMC but one having only one gate will be kept open for emergency. #### F. Precautions to be taken in the case of emergency, announcements and signal display

Stable Signal at all interlocking, crossing, platform, gate 18 mins non-traffic hours and A/C pipes will be disinfected which will come under guidelines (interlocking, crossing, platform, gate 18 mins non-traffic hours, etc.) will be maintained as per protocol of every 2 hours daily. In case of emergency, stoppage at the station, having train control and be deployed after making an announcement inside the train by Train Operator and at the station by Station Controller.

#### G. Train and other facilities

Prohibition on walking on the tracks will be enforced. In case of violation, there will be imposed a fine of Rs. 5000 or 60 days imprisonment or both for violation of the rule. The above steps have been taken by NDMC to establish the trust of the passengers on public transport as a safe mobility choice. NDMC has always worked towards providing safe and comfortable journey to the commuters and will continue to provide a reliable and safe public transport system to the commuters.
